1. Attendance, Introductions:

City Staff Present: Terri Partch, City Engineer; Dick Weinberg, Airport Manager

2. Acceptance of May Minutes

The May minutes were accepted.

3. Airport Planning Map Update:

Commissioners were concerned about the cost of the tunnel proposed for South Bridge. There was concern that because of the price tag of the tunnel under the runway, some people may decide that keeping the airport open was too expensive. They asked about moving the alignment just slightly further south.

4. Municipal Code & Airport Rules/Regulations Changes Update/Lien Determination from Karl Hanlon:

Comments have been submitted to the City attorney. The response is still pending.

5. Ideas on Airport Fixed Base Operator and Airport Beautification Improvements:

Commissioners expressed interest in developing conceptual plan, similar to 6th street, but hopefully more economical.

6. Airport Wayfinding:

There was discussion of improving wayfinding for the Airport. The City Engineer noted the City was developing a way finding plan, and that the route out to Four Mile could easily include a sign providing direction to the airport.

7. Budget:

There was discussion of the airport budget. The Commission believes that Jet A tank fuel would be a revenue generator for the airport. Jet A fuel is needed for emergency fire operations. Currently Flight for Life is using the airport.
